<u>Continuous Internal Assessment</u>: The performance of a student in each course is evaluated in terms of percentage of marks with a provision for conversion to grade points. Evaluation for each course shall be done by a continuous internal assessment by the course teacher concerned as well as by an end semester examination and will be consolidated at the end of the course.

Improvement in CIA marks: Students who have failed in the CIA are permitted to improve their CIA in the immediate subsequent semester, on paying a fee of Rs. 500 per paper within 20 days of publication of Autonomous Examinations results and they should submit two assignments and write two tests. Marks secured for the attendance in the particular semester shall be considered for CIA component. There are no limits in chances for improving internal assessment marks in any of the UG Courses. But, only one chance per PG Course is allowed for improving internal assessment marks. However the candidate can write and improve the Aggregate in the Semester Examination any number of times.
