Online feedback system developed by the college was used to obtain feedback from the students during the year 2021-2022.


2. Response:

3. Analysis of Feedback:




- 2. Transparency in conducting examination and declaration of results.

3. Quality of Teaching-Learning Resources


(a) Excellent(82%) (b) Average(10%) (c) Satisfied(8%) (d) Unsatisfied(0%).


4. Counseling before examination

(a) Excellent(74%) (b) Average(10%) (c) Satisfied(15%) (d) Unsatisfied(1%).





Each tutor in charge and mentors give them enough training to appear for the examinations.


- 6. Teaching in this college.

7. Course/Curriculum


(a) Excellent(79%) (b) Average(10%) (c) Satisfied(10%) (d) Unsatisfied(1%).

8. Teaching aids


(a) Excellent(82%) (b) Average(10%) (c) Satisfied(8%) (d) Unsatisfied(0%).


9. Innovative Teaching


